Comets Grab Lead in Seventh, Defeat Detroit Catholic Central

Grand Ledge snatched the lead late in the game in a 6-5 victory over Detroit Catholic Central on Tuesday. The game was tied at five in the bottom of the seventh, when Sophomore Caleb Estrada doubled to score the game-winning run in a predetermined 9 inning game.
